Teachers can assess what the school has and what appropriate is needed. Pine Street just did this - cost was \$10 000, (3 classes at each grade) Mills Haven did a Spell a Thon to raise money - \$10 000, would need teachers buy-in Usually purchased from Scholastic, purchasing power from Literacy experts Books stay in the school even after teachers leave.
